The Scholarship Committee determines all monetary awards based on the following criteria:

- A. Academic and Scholastic Achievements.
Submit actual transcript of grades.
- B. Financial Need.
- C. Potential for success.
The personal statement will be reviewed and the committee will consider the person's achievements and goals. For example, you could include information on how you will use your chosen career to benefit or improve the environment, humanity, or society in general for the good of all people. This category is most subjective.
