Septage	<b>\$70.00 per 1,000 gallons</b>
Passenger Tires & Standard Pick-up (under 17 inches)	<b>\$1.50 no rim \$3.00 with rim</b>
Commercial Truck Tires (17–24 inches)	<b>\$5.00 no rim \$50.00 with rim</b>
Industrial Tires (over 24 inches)	<b>\$35.00 no rim \$100.00 with rim</b>
8.3–24 thru 15.5–38	<b>\$100.00 no rim</b>

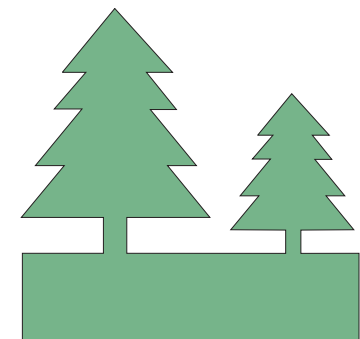

# HOW TO RECYCLE IN LOUDON

## CARDBOARD:

Flatten cardboard, no need to remove labels or staples. Flatten cereal boxes (remove inner bag). Brown paper bags, beer carriers, and cardboard boxes are acceptable.

## NEWSPAPER:

Place in a paper bag or tie in bundles (do not use wire). Inserts may be left in paper.

## MIXED PAPER:

Magazines, phone books (remove covers), office paper, catalogues, mailings.

## CLOTHING:

Clean items of clothing in good condition, footwear, stuffed animals, and bedding.

## ALUMINUM:

Soda and beer cans only. Rinse out beverage cans and deposit in receptacle provided. No cat food cans (they are a different grade).

## TIN CANS:

Empty and rinse. No need to flatten or remove labels. Metal lids from glass jars, bi-metal cans, empty aerosol cans, and empty dried paint cans are also accepted.

## GLASS:

Glass bottles and jars only. Rinse out, remove caps, and stoppers. No window glass or cookware.

## COMPOST:

Leaves, garden and yard vegetation. No brush. Kitty litter if removed from container.

## PLASTIC:

Only #1 and #2 plastic items are acceptable. Food or beverage containers should be emptied completely and rinsed. Caps or covers should be removed and discarded. See the list of specific acceptable items posted at the collection bins. Automotive oil, anti-freeze, or other toxic chemical containers are not allowed.
