LOUDON RECYCLES!

CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard only. Flatten the boxes; not necessary to remove labels or staples. Pizza boxes must be clean and empty. No food grade wax corrugated cardboard boxes.

CLOTHING

Clean items of clothing in good condition, footwear, stuffed animals, and bedding. Must be bagged.

COMPOST

Leaves and yard vegetation. No brush.

TIN CANS

Please empty and rinse. No need to flatten or remove labels. Metal lids from glass jars, bi-metal cans, and empty aerosol cans are recyclable. Empty, dried paint cans are also accepted.

Glass

Glass bottles and jars only. Rinse out, remove caps, and stoppers.

No window glass or cookware.

ALUMINUM

Soda and beer cans only. Rinse out beverage cans and deposit in receptacle provided. No pie plates, or aluminum foil. *These are a different grade.*) Aluminum cat food containers should be thrown in with tin cans.

PLASTIC

Only #1 and #2 plastic items are acceptable. Food and beverage containers should be completely emptied and clean. Bottle caps or container covers should be removed and discarded.

NOT ALLOWED

- Dunkin' Donut cups
- Yogurt, cottage cheese and similar types of containers
- Automotive oil, anti-freeze
- Toxic chemical containers

at the Transfer Station and
affixed to the vehicle to use the facility
and the Town Beach.
