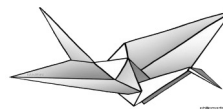


### Afternoon Movie

### Tween Crafts

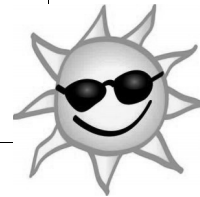
