Polling Place Campaigning / Electioneering Rules Loudon, NH

Rules:

- Campaign signs / banners / flags / etc. must be physically held by a person.
 NH RSA 659:43 VI.
- 2. Campaign signs / banners / flags / etc. are not allowed to be free standing. NH RSA 659:43 V. and VI.
- 3. Campaign signs / banners / flags / etc. shall not be affixed to the polling place buildings or grounds. NH RSA 659:43 V.
- 4. People holding signs and all portions of their signs must remain behind the cones / markers used to designate ways of egress. NH RSA 659:43
- 5. Campaigners must always maintain a clear passage for voters and vehicular traffic. NH RSA 659:43 II.
- 6. Signs, and the people holding signs, cannot impede voters traveling from the parking area to polls in any way. NH RSA 659:43 II.
- 7. Campaigners may not interact with the voters unless they come to you. Campaigners may not call out to voters or try to hand them items / materials. NH RSA 659:43 II.
- 8. No campaign materials (signs, shirts, hats, buttons, flyers, etc.) may be displayed within the polling area. NH RSA 652:16-h

Examples of electioneering that is not allowed:

Freestanding structures holding signs / banners / flags / etc. are not allowed. All signs / banners / flags / etc. must be physically held by a person. (see Rules 1 and 2).



In the examples to the right, yard signs affixed to the ground are not allowed. (see Rule 3)



The examples to the right of hats and buttons are not allowed within the polling area (assuming the candidate is on the ballot) - (see Rule 8)
