Attached is an application for the Loudon Zoning Board of Adjustment. Your <u>completed</u> application must be received no later than 15 days prior to the next scheduled Zoning Board of Adjustment meeting. Having the completed application returned to this office by the deadline would allow you to be placed on the agenda.

*Please submit along with application 12 reduced-size (11" x 17") legible copies of the plat, and 3 sets of abutter labels.

This application must be accompanied by a plot plan which is drawn to scale and is of sufficient detail to support the statements made in this application, and to illustrate compliance with the special conditions required in the ordinance. At a minimum, the plot plan must show the location and dimension of existing and proposed building footprints, setback distances to the property lines and road right of way; the location of wells and septic systems; significant physical or topographic limitations to the development of the lot; and parking and loading areas as applicable. Setback distances from roads must be based on the distance from the edge of the right of way, not the pavement edge.

If you are uncertain of the road right of the way location, contact the Town Road Agent for more information.

The Zoning Board meets on the fourth Thursday of each month at 7:00 pm at the Loudon Town Office at 55 South Village Road. All applications may take two hearings before your application will be granted or denied. Please note that the Zoning Board of Adjustment meets only once a month. All fees must be paid in full and accompanied by a completed application not later than fifteen days prior to the public hearing date.

If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me at the telephone number above. Office hours are Monday-Thursday from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm and Tuesday evenings from 5:00-9:00.
